Fined \$100

The campaign expenses of a candidate for the Rhode Island House of Representatives were increased \$100 today when the Oakland Oaks professional basketball team fined 6-10 rookie Jim Hadnot for failing to show up for practice.

Hadnot, a former McClymonds High School star who won All-America recognition at Providence College, is in Rhode Island winding up his campaign against a multimillionaire Republican assemblyman, Frederick Lippit, Hadnot is a Democrat.

"We wish him well in the election," Oaks general manager Joe Anzivino said, "But we've got a little campaign of our own to get going and he figures in it."

Hadnot's fine, Anzivino said, will increase \$50 a day starting Wednesday midnight.

"If he wins the election, of course, we'll call the fines off," Anzivino said.
